The probabilistic Temperature forecasts in Sri Lanka for February 2025 as given below.

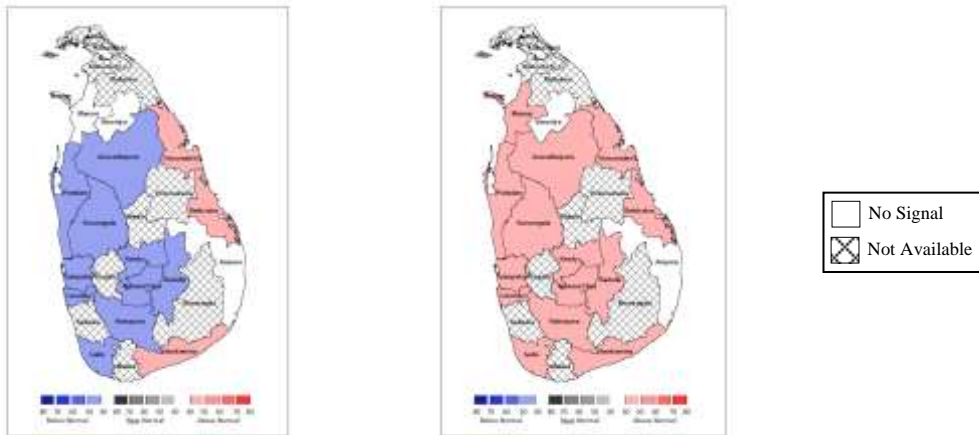

Figure 1 shows the Probabilistic forecast for Maximum Temperatures in Sri Lanka during February 2025. Accordingly, there is a chance of experiencing slightly below the normal Maximum(day) temperatures in Anuradhapura, Puttalam, Kurunegala, Colombo, Gampaha Galle, Rathnapura, Nuwara Eliya, Kandy and Badulla districts and slightly above the normal Maximum(day) temperatures in Trincomalee, Hambantota and Batticaloa districts for the month of February 2025.

Figure 2 shows the Probabilistic forecasts for Minimum (night) temperature forecast for Sri Lanka during February 2025. Accordingly, there is a chance of experiencing slightly above the normal Minimum Temperatures in Mannar, Anuradhapura, Puttalam, Kurunegala, Gampaha, Colombo, Galle, Hambantota, Rathnapura, Kandy, Nuwara Eliya, Badulla, Batticaloa and Trincomalee districts for the month of February 2025.

Probabilistic Temperature Forecast from February to April 2025 (FMA)

The probabilistic Temperature forecast for February, March and April season (FMA) 2025 for Sri Lanka as given below.

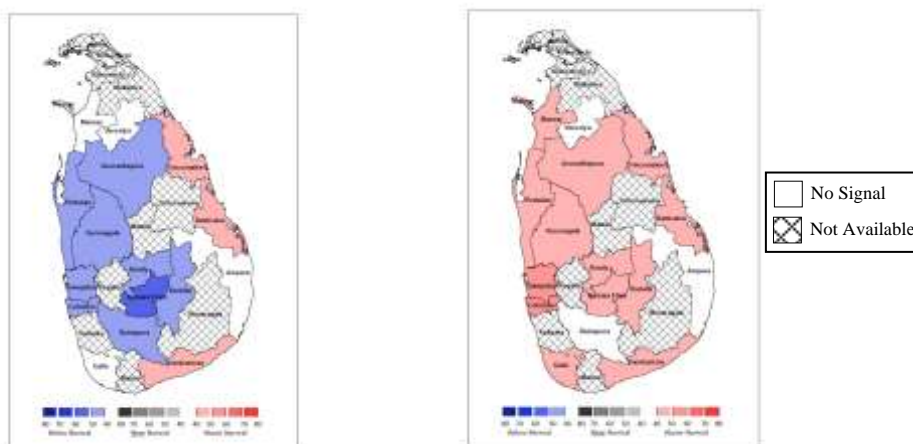

Figure 3 shows the probabilistic forecast for Maximum Temperatures during FMA season 2025. There is a higher chance of experiencing slightly below the normal Maximum Temperatures in Anuradhapura, Puttalam, Kurunegala, Gampaha, Colombo, Rathnapura, Kandy, Nuwara Eliya and Badulla districts and slightly above the normal Maximum Temperatures in Trincomalee, Batticaloa and Hambantota districts (Figure 3) for the FMA season 2025.

Figure 4 shows the probabilistic forecast for Minimum Temperatures during FMA season 2025. Accordingly, there is a higher chance of experiencing slightly above the normal Minimum Temperatures in Mannar, Anuradapura, Puttalam, Kurunegala, Gampaha, Colombo, Galle, Hambantota, Kandy, Nuwara Eliya, Badulla, Trincomalee and Batticaloa districts (Figure 4) during FMA season 2025.

Note- Temperature forecasts are not available in **Matara, Kegalle, Kalutara, Monaragala, Polonnaruwa, Jaffna, Killinochchi, Mullativu and Mathale** districts due to unavailability of Climate data.
