## Advisory for Very Severe Cyclonic Storm “Biparjoy” over East-Central Arabian Sea

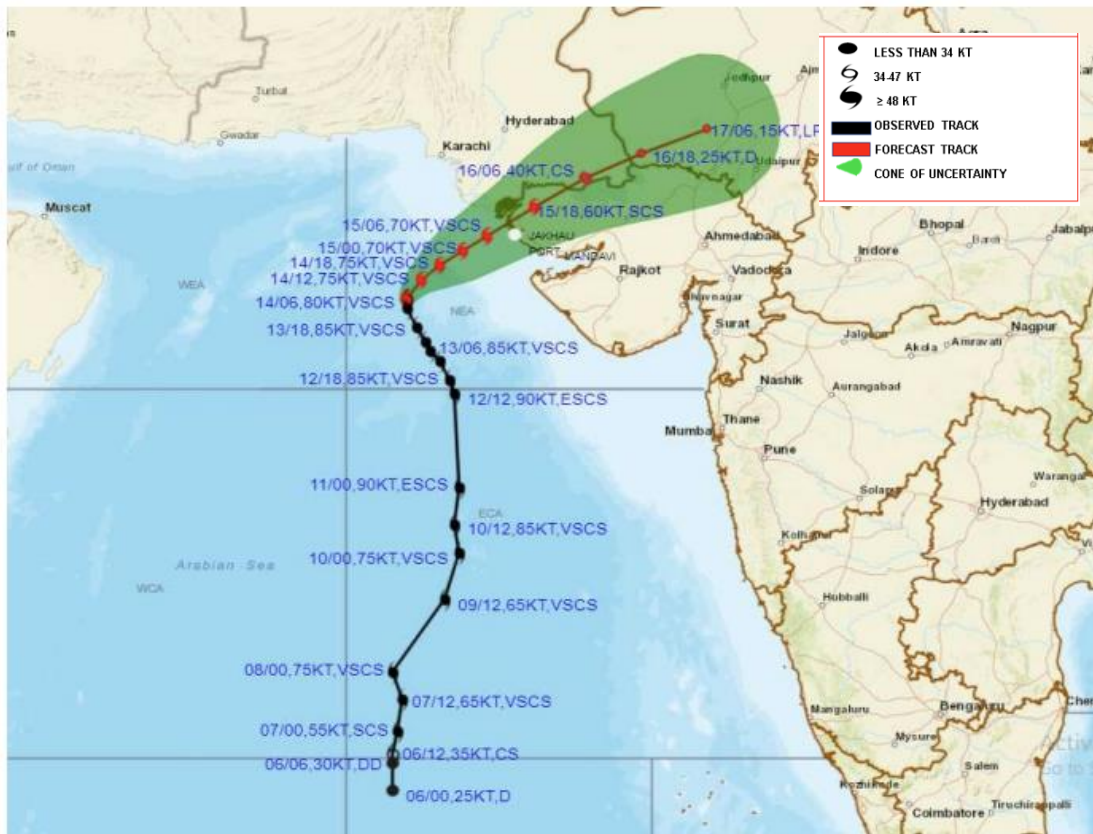

### For Multi-day boats in the Deep Arabian Sea

#### PLEASE BE AWARE!

The very severe cyclonic storm “BIPARJOY” (pronounced as “BIPORJOY”) over East-Central Arabian Sea was located near latitude 21.9°N and longitude 66.3°E at 0830 hours of 14th June, 2023. It would move nearly north-eastwards during next 24 hours and cross Pakistan coasts by evening of 15th June.

Wind speed will be (145-155) kmph and can increase up to (160-170) kmph in sea areas bounded by (18N - 25N) and (65E – 75E) during next 24 hours due to this system.

Heavy showers or thundershowers; High, very high at times seas can also be expected in above sea areas.



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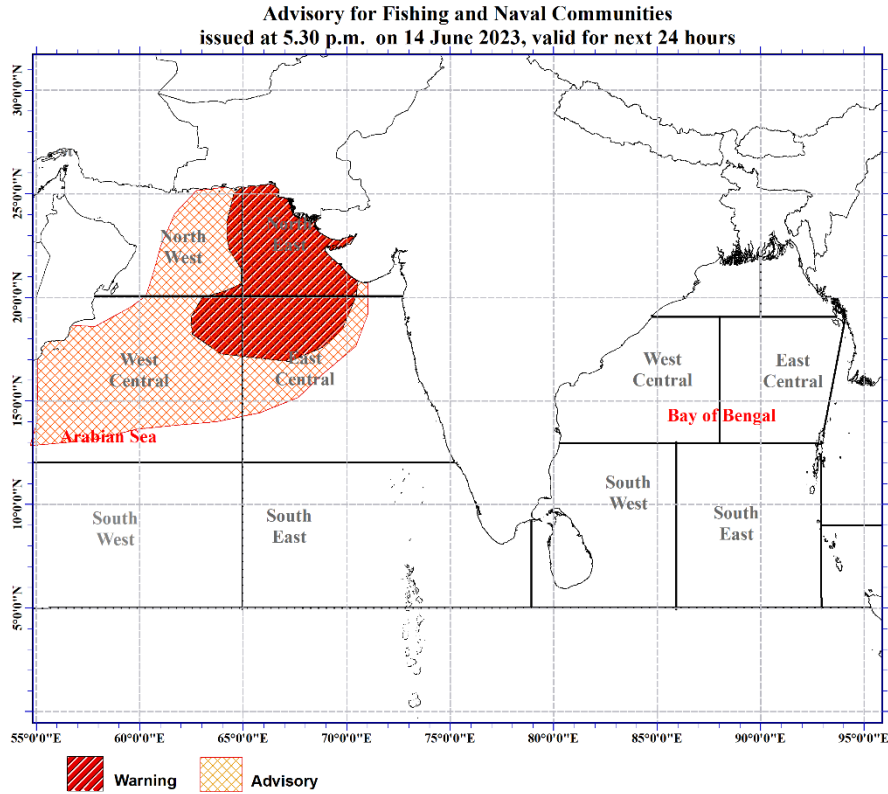
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### Actions Required:

- Naval and fishing communities are advised not to venture into the sea areas bounded by (18N - 25N) and between (65E – 75E) until further notice.
- Those who are out at aforementioned sea regions are advised to return to coasts or moved safer areas immediately.
- This is the final advisory with regarding the Very Severe Cyclonic Storm “Biparjoy”. Fishing and naval community are requested to be attentive to future sea area forecasts issued by the Department of Meteorology at 07.00 a.m. (weather forecast for multi-day boats).
